

1. What is the University Ranking / Accreditation Status?

Yenepoya (deemed to be University) has been ranked 92 by National Institutional Ranking Framework, MHRD, Govt. of India 2018. It is accredited by NAAC with 'A' Grade in 2015 effective till 2020. The university is recognized by UGC under section 3(A) of the UGC Act 1956 as per notification number F 9-11/2007 U-3 dated 27-02-2007.
